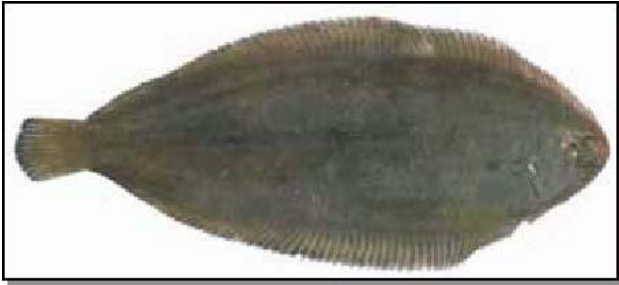


WHICH OF THE TWO IS A REAL SOLE FILLET?

Solea vulgaris (Soleidae Family) **SOLE** (Obligatory denomination: M.D. Agricultural Policies 31/01/08). It lives in the Mediterranean and the eastern Atlantic. Very high quality species, much sought after on all our markets, where is regularly found and sold fresh or frozen, both whole and in fillets. It has delicious and delicate white-pinkish meat. Fillet retail price: from 25 to 35 €/Kg.



According to the MD 31/01/08 both species with the Latin denomination *Pangasius hypophthalmus* and *Pangasius micronemus* (Pangasidae family) must have the mandatory denomination of **PANGASIO** in Italian.

They live in the fresh waters of the southern part of the Asian continent. They have also been introduced in other rivers for aquaculture purposes. They are two of the most important species farmed in Thailand; the interest for them on our markets where they arrive in form of fillets is growing.

They have a white-pinkish meat. Fillets retail price: around 8-10 €/Kg.
